Please specify your preferred method of presentation:

- A. Paper Session – 20 minutes of presentation and 10 minutes of discussion.
- B. Workshop – 20 minutes of presentation and 40 minutes of discussion.

Please mind the following guidelines:

- The abstract has to be written in English language only.
- The abstracts should be typed in Arial font (11 point), double-spaced
- Abstracts should be emailed as a word or open office document.

Suggested themes:

1. Different models of mentoring: case studies from around the world.
2. Mentoring as a compensatory resource in the educational system.
3. Cultural sensitivity and cross-cultural aspects in mentoring.
4. Mentoring for special populations.
5. Characteristics of a good mentor.
6. The impact of guidance for mentors.
7. Integration of mentoring in the curriculum of universities and colleges.
8. Benefits for mentees and mentors.
9. Enrichment activities.

All participants are invited to bring posters and written materials. We are also interested in showing film material. Please give notice to your junior researchers/students, we would like to welcome them, too.
